



SEPTEMBER 27TH & OCTOBER 4TH NORTH-SOUTH PARKWAY SUB-AREA STUDY

Northern Mecklenburg County and southern Iredell County is one of the fastest growing areas in North Carolina. In addition to rapid population growth, the area has limited north-south roadways to accommodate increased traffic. In 2010, the Urban Land Institute completed a study that identified the need for north-south connectivity and recommended a new facility. The North-South Parkway would complement existing NC 115 through the area and offer additional access for economic growth and development.

In 2018, local jurisdictions, including the Towns of Huntersville, Davidson, Mooresville, Cornelius, and Iredell County agreed that a comprehensive effort must be undertaken to link their efforts together in a cohesive manner. Your input is critical for providing local communities with a cohesive plan for a new North-South transportation corridor.
