

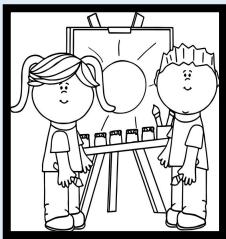

Overview



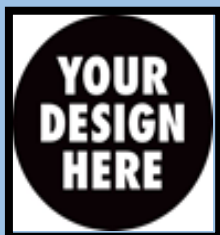
