Preparing for a Visit:



Make an appointment

Call to schedule an appointment



Bring proof of residence

Such as a current utility bill



Bring proof of income OR any means of financial support for your household

Examples: Recent paycheck stubs, letter of certification from ANY public assistance programs, recent tax return ONLY for self-employed. We also accept a wage verification form. This form is provided by the Health Department and should be completed by your employer stating your gross income and frequency of pay.

Income information is needed to help us determine if patients qualify for a discount.

If you are under the age of 18, you have the legal right in North Carolina to get Birth Control in a confidential manner. We encourage you to involve your parent in these decisions however, we know this is not always a possibility for all young adults.

Did you Know?

Testicular Cancer

The average age at the time of diagnosis of testicular cancer is about 33 years. This is largely a disease of young and middle-aged men. It is important to do your monthly self-exam. (www.cancer.org)

Available to women who are pregnant and breastfeeding. *Children up to 5 years of age.

Basic dental services to Iredell County residents of all ages.

Prenatal services for low-risk pregnancies.



Immunizations

Provides all required and most recommended vaccines to infants, children and adults.

Offers a variety of lab testing, most without a physician's order.

MALE SERVICES



This program provides services to help you prevent unintended pregnancy and maintain your reproductive health. The Family Planning program plays a critical role in ensuring access to a broad range of family planning and related sexual health services for low-income or uninsured males. Our clinicians provide a confidential healthcare experience that is sensitive to your needs.

Male Visits :

- Wellness exam, including testicular and prostate exam
- Blood pressure check
- Screening, STD testing/treatment
- Prevention education on STDs
- Education on pregnancy prevention
- Distribution of over-the-counter pregnancy prevention methods

Vasectomy Program

This program is sponsored by the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services; supported by the Title X grant. The cost of the surgery is determined using a sliding fee scale based on family size and income. Many men can receive the vasectomy at no cost. The service is available each year until the funds are depleted. To qualify for the vasectomy program you must be a North Carolina resident at least 21 years of age.

Male birth control options



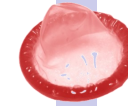
Abstinence : ★ ★ ★ ★ ★ Great

- Not having vaginal or anal sex
- Prevents pregnancy 100%
- Prevents STDs 100%



Pull Out : ★ Not Good

- Not ejaculating into vagina
- Can easily get pregnant
- **Does NOT prevent STDs**



Male Condom : ★ ★ ★ OK

- Must be used correctly and consistently

• Decreases risk of pregnancy

• Decreases risk of STDs ★ ★ ★ ★ Very Good



Vasectomy:

- Permanent surgical procedure

STD Screening

STD testing is offered in our Male Wellness (Family Planning) clinic and in our STD clinic. There is no charge to patients for STD testing or treatment.

Routine screening includes testing for:

- Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV)
- Syphilis
- Gonorrhea
- Non-gonococcal urethritis (NGU)

Additional testing done if indicated by symptoms or risk factors:

- Herpes culture
- Hepatitis C
- Hepatitis B
