

## Procedure for Recycling Shingles

- Upon arrival, all shingles to be recycled need to be physically checked by an Iredell County SW Employee.
- Upon approval, clean loads of shingles will be accepted at a reduced rate of \$15.00 per ton and no Solid Waste tax.
- If loads are not clean, they will be directed to the landfill and charged a rate of \$35.00 per ton, plus the \$2.00 Solid Waste tax.
- All recycled shingles must have a completed Shingle Supplier Certification Form, available at the landfill scale.
- All shingles must arrive at the landfill site one hour before closing unless in dump bed.

## ASPHALT SHINGLE RECYCLING



The Iredell County Solid Waste Facility is proud to announce to homeowners and the businesses of Iredell County a way to save “EXTRA BUCKS” by recycling old shingles.

By choosing to recycle shingles rather than disposing of them in the landfill, customers can take advantage of a \$22.00 per ton savings! Our facility will require source separation at the job site. Materials from flat and built-up roofing systems are disposed of rather than accepted for recycling due to the higher use of asbestos roofing materials in those systems. Contractors are instructed to separate tear-off shingles into either a dedicated trailer or to layer their waste when loading so that the shingles can be easily separated from the unacceptable debris.

## TEAR-OFF ASPHALT SHINGLE RECYCLING

List of Acceptable and Unacceptable Materials

### YES:

Include these items:

- Shingles
- Nails

### NO:

Do NOT include these items:

- Wood
- Metal flashing, gutters, etc.
- Rolls or sheets of felt paper
- Plastic wrap or buckets
- Paper, garbage, or any other waste material
- Built-up asphalt roofing
- Asbestos-containing material
- Shingles containing mastics
